Respite

Residential Habilitation

- Service designed to have valued outcomes
- A plan reviewed every six months is required
- Individualized programs and schedules
- Behavioral and occasionally other clinical supports
- Large demand to engage individuals into their community
- Other supports include, general household education, some personal care, general guidance on health-related issues, etc.

Respite

- To provide relief to the primary caregiver(s)
- No plan required but documentation by staff is an agency requirement

Residential Habilitation

- Currently provided to approximately 310 individuals
- Some individuals have both respite and residential habilitation
- Currently served in 8 counties
- Seven Coordinators oversee the activity
- Currently have approximately 135 part time providers (direct service staff)
